Athletics at St. Ursula School

St. Ursula School is proud to offer a variety of Diocesan sponsored, extra curricular sports for its students in grades 3rd through 8th, including:

Coed JV & Varsity Cross Country

Cross country begins in August of each school year. JV - grades 4, 5, and 6; Varsity - grades 7 and 8.

Coed JV & Varsity Soccer

Coed Developmental Soccer

Fall soccer begins in September and Spring soccer begins in April.

General Information

Athletic Registration will take place during the months of September, October, and April at the school. Parents will be required to attend and provide the following:

- Your child's *Physician's Release Form*, *Emergency Information Form*, and *Insurance Documentation Form*. These forms will be used for all of the sports in which your child is participating during the current school year. Forms are available on the school website.
- Applicable fees for sport. Fees cover such items as uniforms, equipment, referees, field and gym time.
- Written commitment for volunteer work during at least one Bingo per school year.

In addition, all student athletes can expect a *Picture Day* during each season. An independent photographer will be at the field or the gym to photograph all of the student athletes. Individual and team photos may be purchased from the photographer.

Pizza Nights will be scheduled at the finish of every season to celebrate a season of wins, or simply a season of fun!

Finally, the *Spring Sports Banquet* is held each May to honor all of the student athletes and their coaches. It is always an evening of fun which includes dinner, dancing, and of course awards.

Rules and Regulations

- All student athletes are expected to show commitment to their team.
- Athletes are expected to come prepared to all games in their full St. Ursula Viking uniform.
- Athletes are expected to attend all practices and games unless there are extenuating circumstances. If a student is unable to attend a practice or a game, they are to notify their coach by phone with sufficient time before the practice or game.

- Athletes are expected to attend all games, regardless of distance from St. Ursula School. Carpooling is encourage to distant fields or gyms.
- Absolutely no profanity, unsportsmanlike conduct or disrespect of any coach, player, or referee will be tolerated from any student, parent, or fan. The coach, principal, or Diocesan officials will take disciplinary action as warranted.
