A weekly update of the happenings in our classroom:

- *The children have really been working hard this week in our class! Especially during their work on the Unit 1 Test.
- *In spelling/phonics we worked on r-controlled vowels: a vowel immediately followed by a r, it doesn't make the vowel a long or short vowel they make their own unique sound. We are discussing Working Together in our second unit in Reading. The story this week was Tara and Tiree. The children worked together in reading the story to a partner during the week. We discussed the setting, characters, and sequence this week as well.
- *In Social Studies we started talking about Groups in our community. They are learning that every group has some type of rules to follow to keep everyone safe. The children have a booklet that they will bring home when we are done with these lessons.
